<u>ORDER</u>

On April 18, 2011, a jury trial commenced between Dolen, the plaintiff, and Ryals, the defendant. On April 20, 2011, after Dolen rested her case-in-chief, Ryals moved for judgment as a matter of law under Rule 50(a), Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. The oral motion (Doc. 161) was granted because the evidence provided no legally sufficient basis for a reasonable jury to find in favor of Dolen. The Clerk shall **ENTER A JUDGMENT** against Dolen and for Ryals on all Dolen's claims (Doc. 88).

After Ryals rested on the counterclaim, Dolen's oral motion (Doc. 163) for judgment under Rule 50(a) was granted because the evidence provided no legally sufficient basis for a reasonable jury to find in favor of Ryals. The Clerk shall **ENTER A JUDGMENT** against Ryals and for Dolen on Ryals' counterclaim (Doc. 93).

The Clerk shall **TERMINATE** any pending motion and **CLOSE** the case. ORDERED in Tampa, Florida, on April 22, 2011.
